

Summary of SCAN's Road Safety Survey

SCAN commissioned Mindset Research, a professional research company, to carry out a survey of the views of Westbury Park residents on road safety. Carried out in April 2022 the survey was completed by 298 respondents, of which 134 have children at either Westbury Park Primary School or the Daisy Chain Nursery.

Main findings:

- 81% said parking issues have a dangerous impact on road safety in Westbury Park
- 63% of respondents described the roads in Westbury Park as 'fairly unsafe', or 'very unsafe'
- The top concerns were 'Children struggling to cross the roads safely' (72% of all respondents said this was an issue) and 'Lack of parking available' (89% said this was an issue)
- 67% said they had witnessed accidents or near misses in Westbury Park - 44% more than once).

The top two issues were reported to be:
